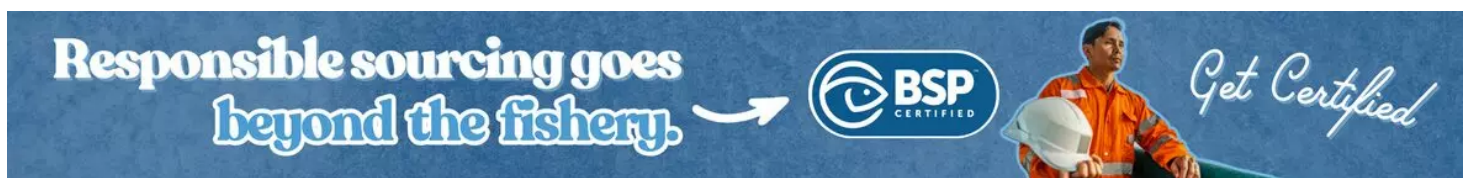

After completing each module, learners have the option to do a final quiz and get a free certificate of completion.
