Board director on three international boards of Grameen Foundation for poverty alleviation.

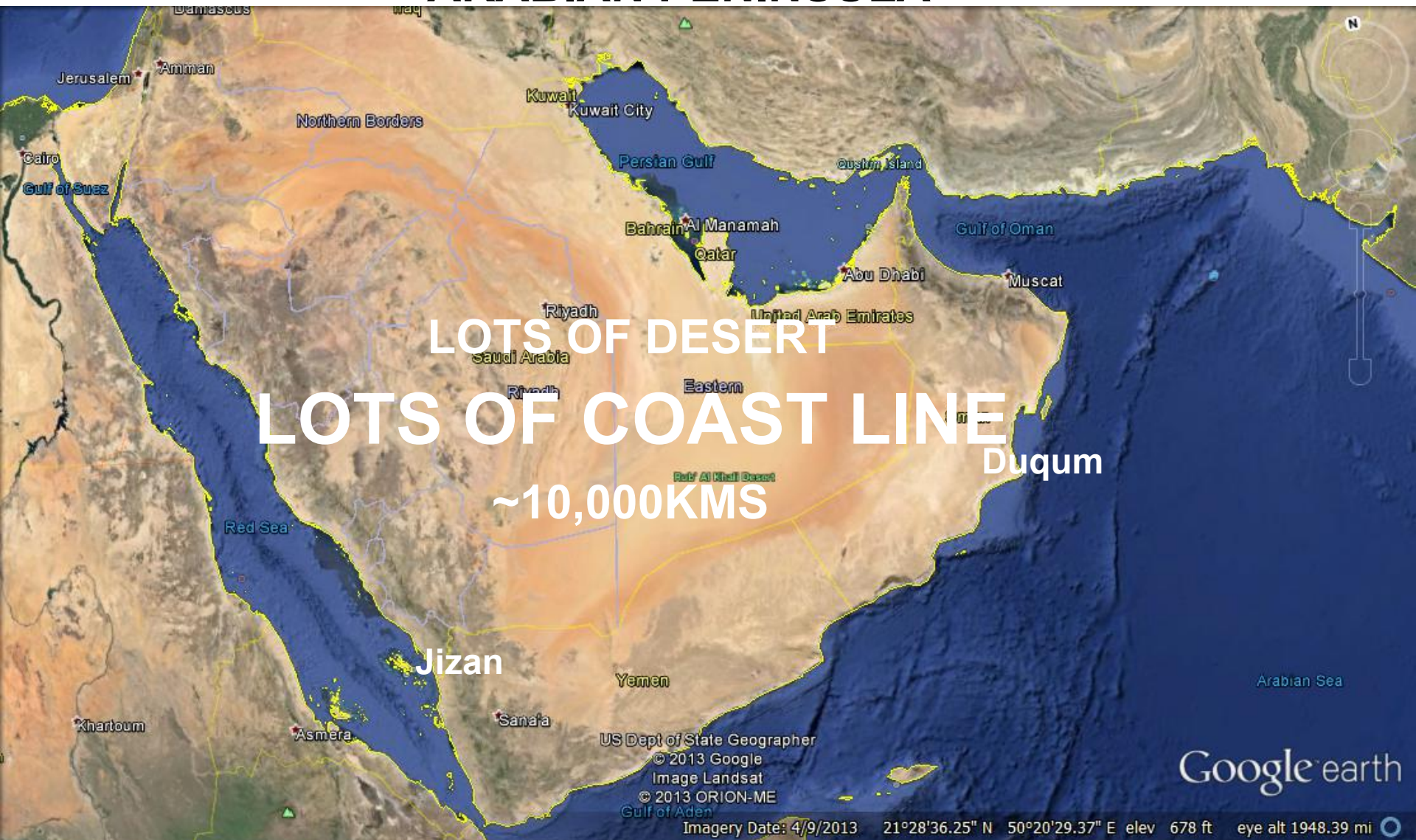

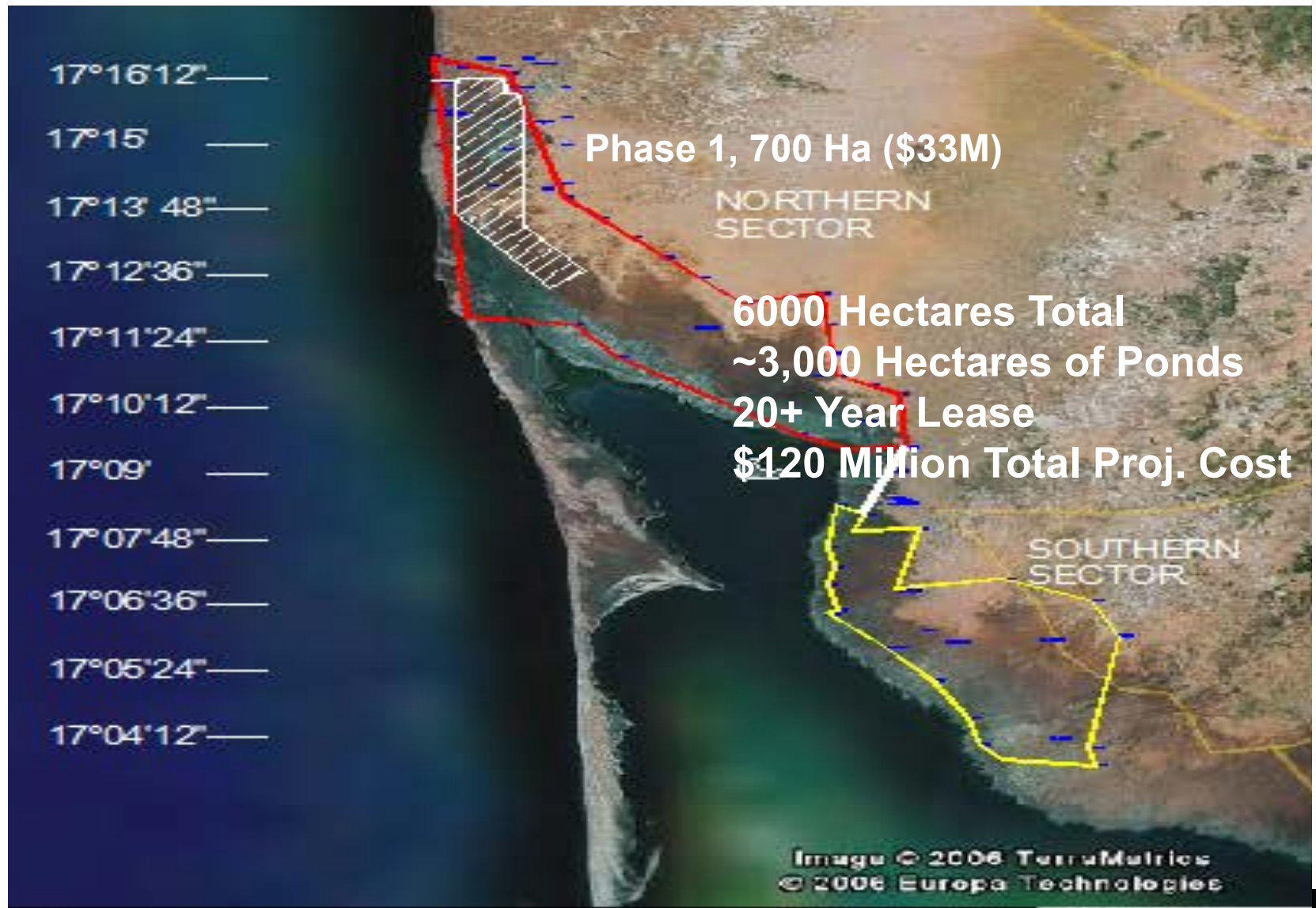

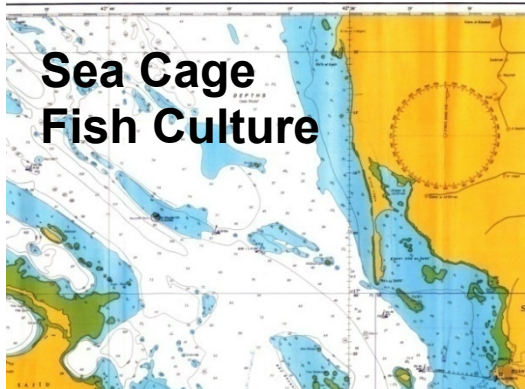

# WHAT WE FOUND OUT

## **The waters bordering the coast line of most of the Arabian Peninsula are superb for warm water marine species**

12 month growing season, long north south coast line with varying water temperatures, high value native species that are acclimated to higher temperatures and salinities, superb infrastructure, little to no industrial pollution along much of the coast line, central geographical position for export by land and sea to Europe and Asia, increasingly appropriate government regulations and investment incentives to support the expansion of the industry in the region, and we are not immune to diseases.
