








Main Commercial Aquaculture Species Combined Growth 2009 – 2014 E





Africa Production

- Aquaculture production has doubled in a decade
 - 1.2 percent to 2.2 percent
- Mostly from freshwater fish farming in sub-Saharan Africa.
- Significant production of tilapia in Egypt.
- A small fraction of production in northern Africa, including marine fish, shrimp and molluscs.
