



What is a fishery?

A fishery is where fish are reared for commercial purposes, a fishing ground or area where fish are caught.


Because of their economic, social and environmental importance, fisheries are governed by complex fisheries management practices and legal regimes that vary widely from country to country.

Fishing with Nets


Over 80% of fish are caught via net fishing. There are a variety of different types of net fishing, including trawling, gillnets, and purse seining schools of fish.



Line fishing is the image that most people


Fishing with Lines
